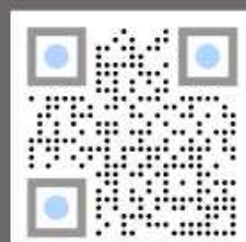

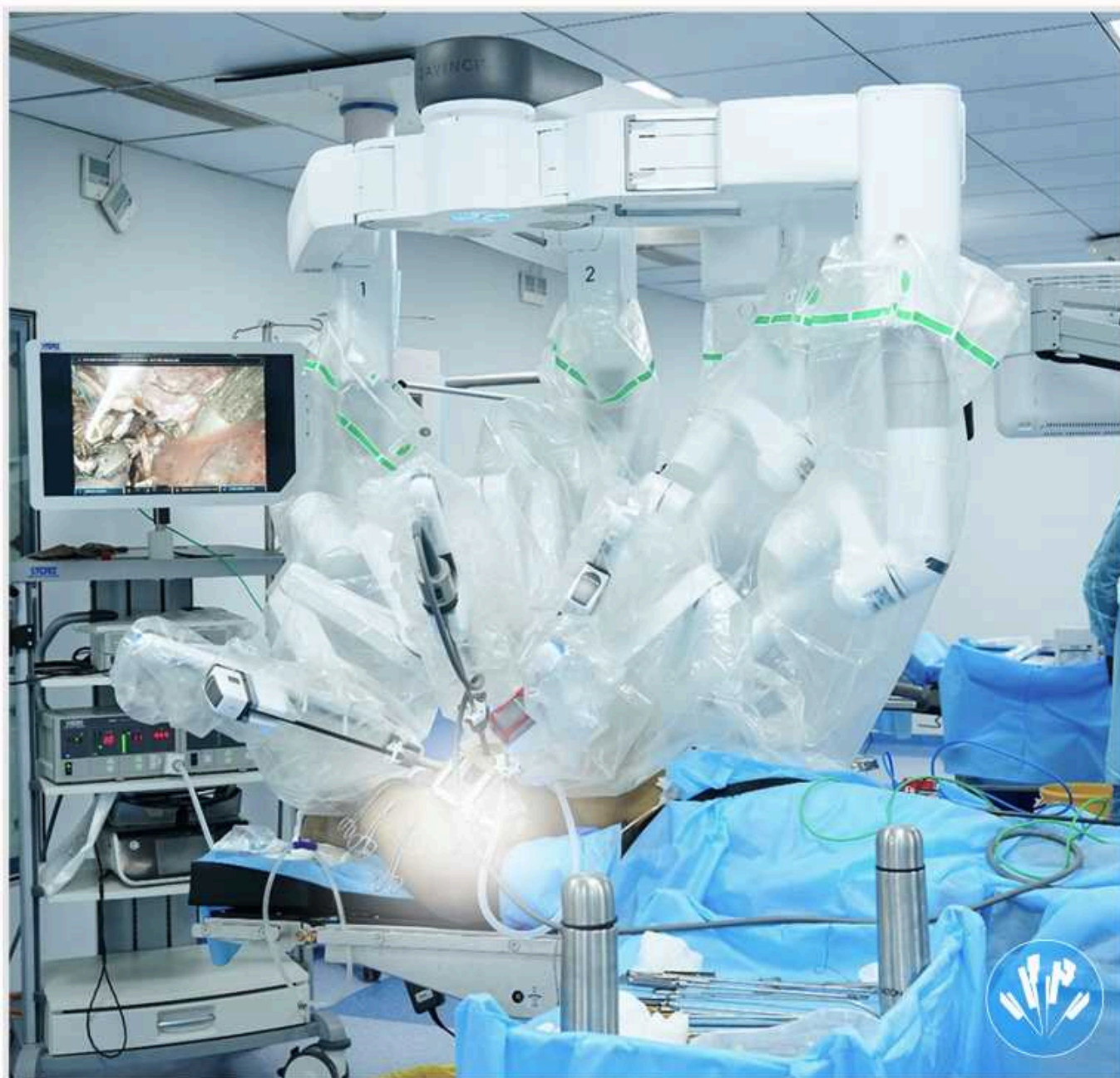


COURSE ELIGIBILITY -
